Grace Wu, born in Taiwan, lives and works in Taipei. Wu currently studies MFA at Taipei National University of the Arts. Wu's works are mostly painting, focusing on contemporary life and the essence of seeing.

在繪畫處理上所追求的平滑表面，源於我們這個時代的觀看經驗：當代的視覺影像改變了我們對「真實」的凝視方式，日常風景被轉化為短暫、極具平滑質感的平面影像。螢幕抹去了作品實際樣貌的細節，在數位宇宙中甚至可以輕易地將作品美化，從而獲得另一件「更好的作品」。抽象繪畫作為一種現當代生活的再現，透過顏料轉移視覺經驗，並將其疊合於載體上，正是在畫布上重製這樣的觀看經驗。

吳德馨近期的展覽包括個展：「漫漫」，Pièce，台北 (2024)。並曾於寶藏巖國際藝術村 (2025)、臺北國際藝術村 (2022)、臺中大墩文化中心 (2020)、臺灣當代文化實驗場 C-LAB(2019) 等展出。

The pursuit of a smooth surface in painting stems from the seeing experiences in the very era. Contemporary imagery has transformed how people gaze at "reality," turning everyday landscapes into fleeting, sleek, and flat visual impressions. Screens have blurred the physical details of artworks, and within the digital realm, it is even easy to enhance or beautify a piece, resulting in what can be perceived as a "better" version.

Through abstract painting, Wu represents contemporary life reconfiguring visual experiences with layering acrylic on mediums. The approach to smoothness recreate and reflect contemporary modes of seeing through the surface.

Grace Wu's recent exhibitions include the solo show: "Day after day", Pièce, Taipei (2024). Her work has also been featured at institutions such as Treasure Hill Artist Village, Taipei (2025), Taipei Artist Village, Taipei (2022), Taichung City Dadun Cultural Center, Taichung (2020), and Taiwan Contemporary Culture Lab (C-LAB) (2019).

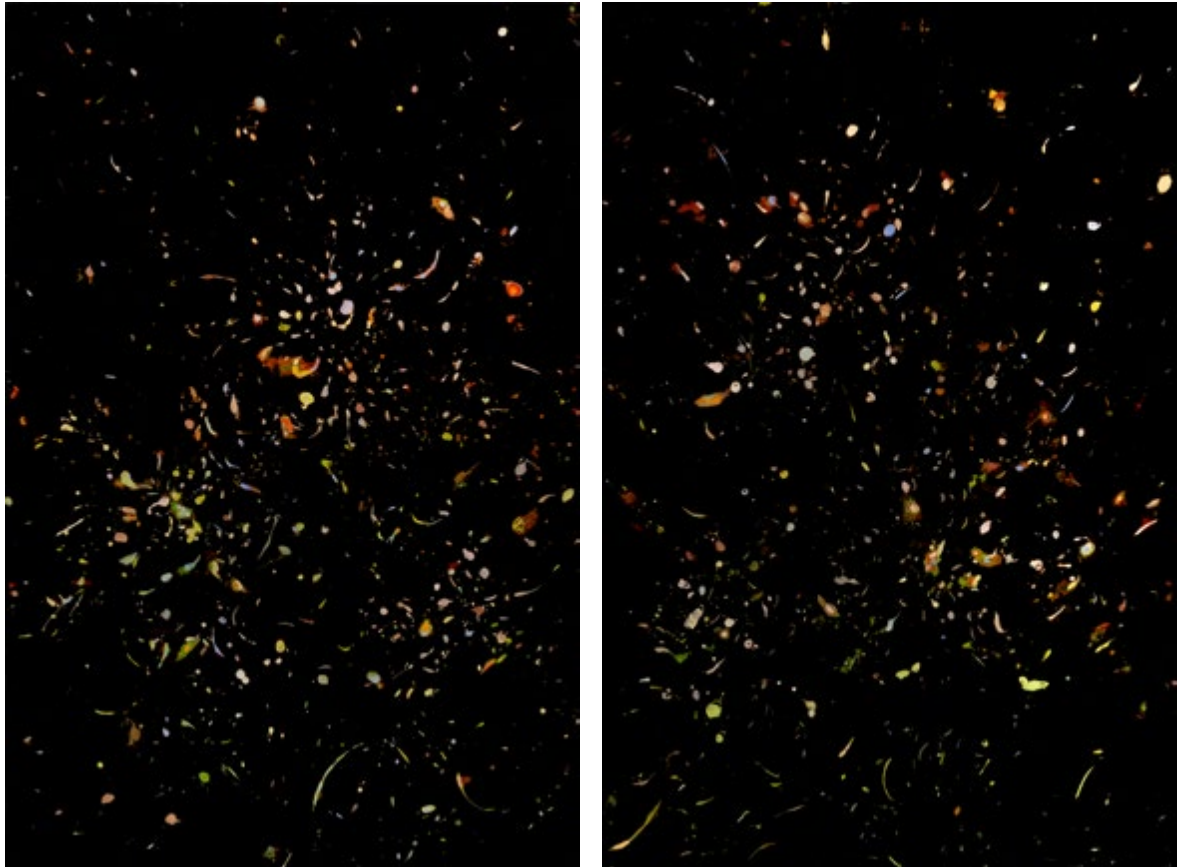

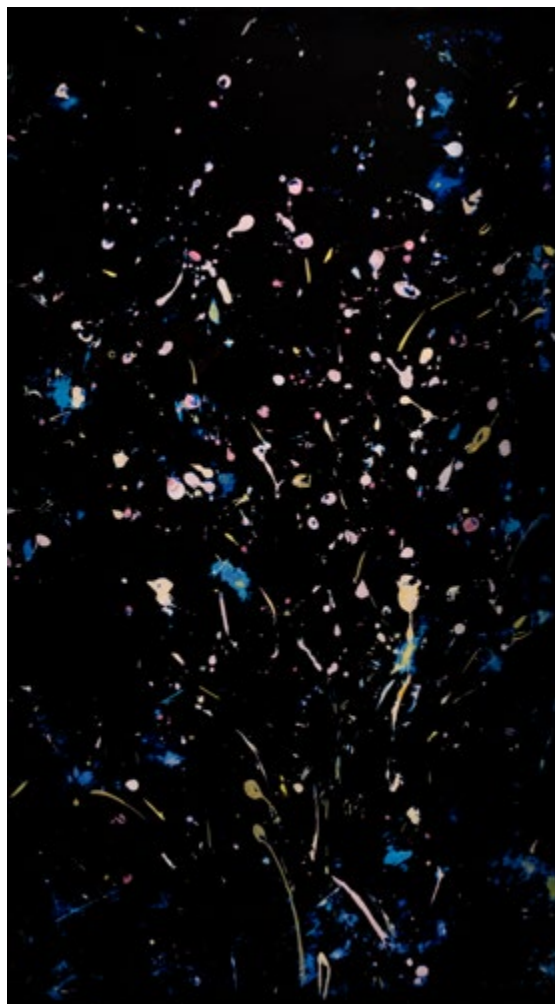

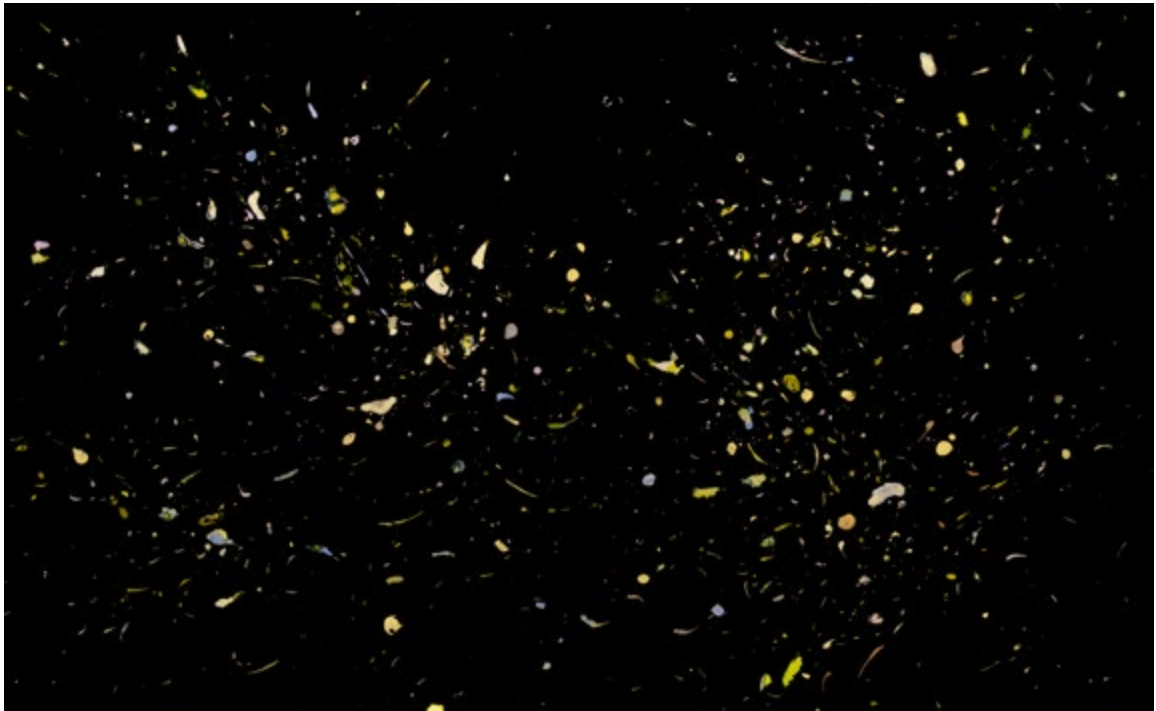

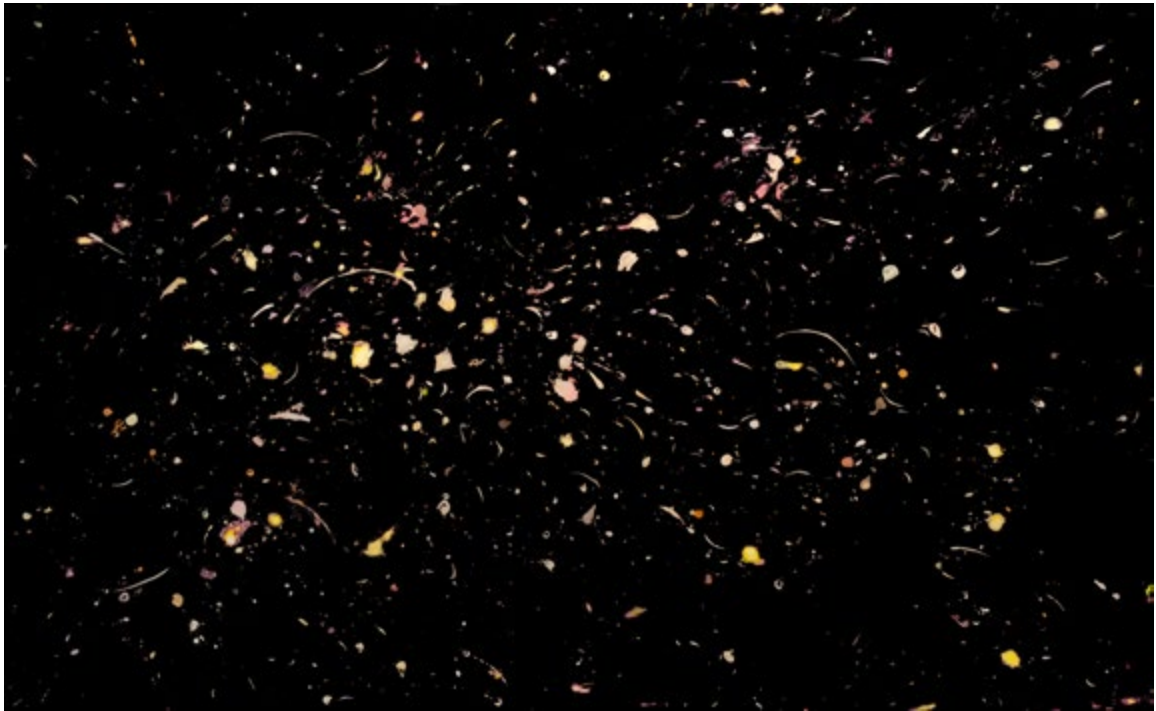

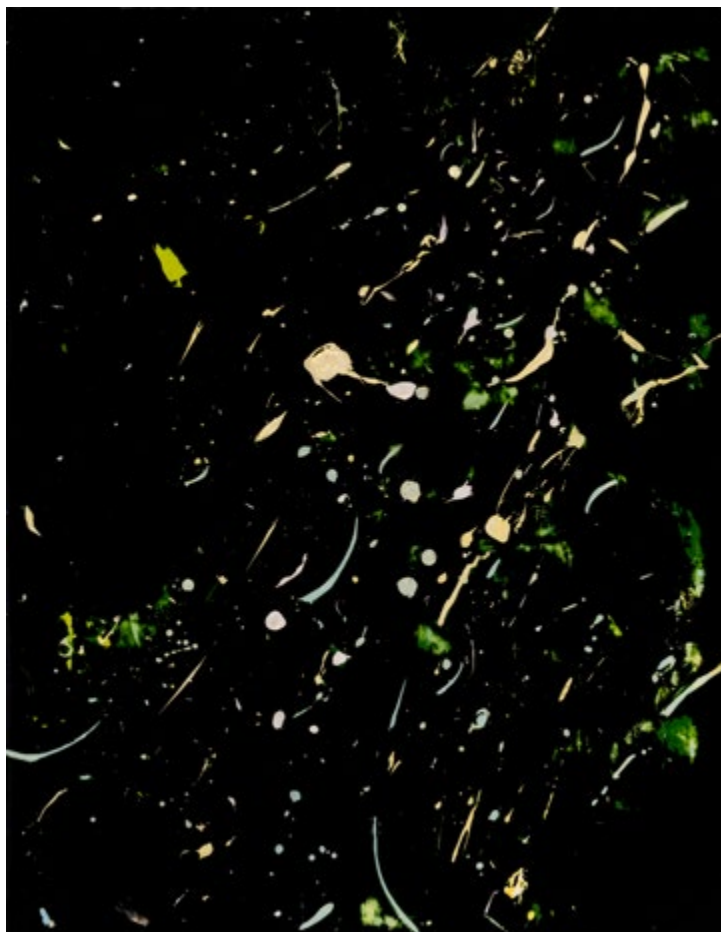

**Lim Sokchanlina**

林・索科謙李納（Lim Sokchanlina）的創作橫跨紀錄性與概念性的藝術實踐，媒材包括攝影、影片、裝置及表演。他透過不同的策略，引起人們對柬埔寨在全球脈絡下的社會、政治、地緣政治、經濟、文化及環境變遷的關注，並探討權力與經濟在我們日常生活與當代現實中的角色與影響。他的創作通常涉及深入的研究，旨在挖掘、解構並紀錄當代的歷史，同時以學習過去為基礎，想像未來的可能性。

Lina works across documentary and conceptual practices with photography, video, installation and performance. Using different strategies, he calls attention to a variety of social, political, geopolitical, economic, cultural and environmental changes in Cambodia in relation to the globe and in the notion of what power and economic play roles in our everyday living and contemporary present. His works usually involve researching to discover, unpack and document the history of the present and the imagination of the future by learning from the past.
